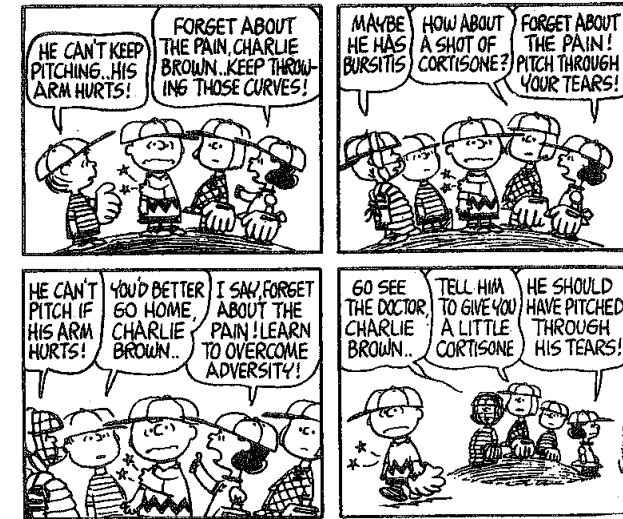
COINS FOR CARING in May will support the Youth Triennium trip this summer. Thank you for sharing your spare change to support the young folks going on this trip.
