PW NEWS!

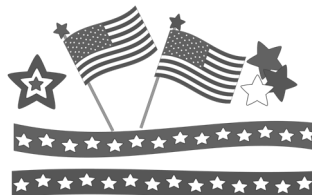
At one time, Paxton Church had as many as 5 Circles. The purpose of the Circles was for Presbyterian Women to meet in small groups for Bible Study, good works and socialization.

Over the years the Circles have united or folded until this year when there were only two Circles – Unity Circle and Circle 2.

Circle 2 first met on February 1, 1977, shortly after Calvary Presbyterian Church merged with Paxton. We have met since then for a total of 42 years.
